GETTING HERE

Windsor Essex is easy to access whether your group arrives by plane, train or auto.

- A quick 15 minutes to downtown, Windsor International Airport offers frequent service via Porter Airlines, Air Canada Jazz and WestJet. Air Canada offers direct flights between Windsor and Montreal, and WestJet flies seasonally between Windsor and Calgary.
- Detroit Metropolitan Airport is only 45 minutes to downtown Windsor. It's one of Delta Airlines' busiest hubs and it's a fantastic option for those travelling in from Western Canada or the United States.
- VIA Rail Canada offers frequent service along the Windsor-Quebec corridor.
- By car or bus, Windsor is a fourhour drive from Toronto, and is easily accessed from the U.S. via the Ambassador Bridge and the Detroit-Windsor Tunnel.

Border crossing between Windsor and Detroit will be quick and convenient with the scheduled 2024 grand opening of the Gordie Howe will feature six auto lanes as well as a multi-use path for pedestrians and cyclists.



SIGNATURE EXPERIENCES

- Windsor's Old Walkerville neighbourhood dates back to the mid-19th century and is a testament to the business acumen of Hiram Walker. Walking tours provide a fascinating reminder of the city's colourful whisky-making heritage.
- The Barrels Bottles & Brews trail is a great way to discover a new generation of craft brewers and distillers. There are 12 stops along the trail, including Walkerville Brewery, FRANK Brewing Co., Brew Microbrewery, J.P. Wiser's and Wolfhead Distillery.
- Drive or cycle the picturesque Essex Pelee Island Coast (EPIC) wine trail to discover 18 local wineries.
- Play with fire at Tsunami Glassworks where groups can make beautiful handblown glass paperweights and ornaments.
- · Splish splash at Adventure Bay Family Water Park, featuring Ontario's only FlowRider indoor surfing machine.

Local Connections: When they weren't out on the course, some of the participating golfers toured the EPIC wineries or attended a Detroit Tigers game. Charitable fundraising activities during the Windsor Championship raised over \$100,000 for The Hospice of Windsor & Essex County. Among the efforts was a charity golf challenge and a special luncheon featuring the two top Canadians on the PGA TOUR, Adam Hadwin and Corey Conners.

The day before the Windsor Championship began, we hosted a kickoff dinner at the club for about 300 guests that featured Detroit Red Wing alumni players Darren McCarty and Kirk Maltby as guest speakers. Throughout the tournament, we provided the golfers with transportation services, on-site food vouchers, local restaurant discounts and dry cleaning services.

For the spectators, we provided local entertainment during the charity golf challenge and we made food and beverages available on the course throughout the week.

We provided volunteers with a shirt and hat as well as meals during their shifts, tickets to Windsor Spitfires and LaSalle Vipers hockey games, and restaurant discount coupons. Part of the \$45 volunteer fee helped us to maximize our donation to the hospice charity.

Tourism Windsor Essex developed a visitors' guide for our event that included maps and information on local festivals and attractions. They're a fantastic group of people to work with who care about this area and are very passionate about what they do.

In terms of community legacies, the Windsor Diving Club will be a major beneficiary of hosting the FINA Diving Grand Prix, and local schools and youth groups will be invited to attend the event and meet the athletes, including Olympic medalists.

We have a strong history of hosting in Windsor and the city did a great job designing their diving facility. It's such an intimate space compared to many other pools that are like cavernous stadiums. I equate it to a band playing a smaller venue-you just get that much more of a closer experience with our sport. Our relationship with the folks at the tourism bureau has been built over the last six or seven years. They're always very helpful in referring us to local event planners and service providers and we're going to be using many of the same people we worked with during the World Series. I find that it's really beneficial to us when a tourism bureau doesn't have a lot of turnover. They have all that built-up knowledge, making it so much easier to host another event there.
